

Try Out and Drafting Policies

Try Outs

Try outs are mandatory for any child in the league age 9 or over. If you child does not attend at least 50% of the try-outs, they will NOT be eligible to play at any level for the 2010 season, and you will forfeit your registration fee. (Players who were on a Major League team for all or part of the 2009 season, and wish to return to the same team for the 2010 season, are the ONLY exception to this rule.)

Drafting

Once teams have been assigned and the season is underway, it is possible that a player on a Minor League team may be drafted up to a Major League team. If this occurs, the Player Agent will be in contact with you. If a Minor League Player refuses to go up to the Major League team, the following things occur:

- 1) The Minor League player will NOT be returned to his original Minor League team, but be assigned to another Minor League team at the discretion of the Player Agent.
- 2) The Minor League player will NOT be eligible for participation in the 2010 All Star teams at the season's end.
